Ultramour

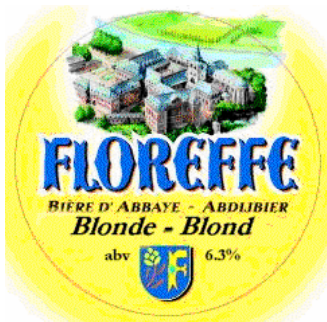
Blanche de Bruxelles **Draught** **4.4%**

A cloudy Belgian White Beer made in the traditional manner with unmalted wheat, coriander and bitter orange peels. Brewed by Lefèbvre just to the south of Brussels.



Anchor Steam Beer **Draught** **5%**

“San Francisco's famous *Anchor Steam*[®], the classic of American brewing tradition since 1896, is virtually handmade, with an exceptional respect for the ancient art of brewing. The deep amber color, thick creamy head, and rich flavor all testify to their traditional brewing methods. *Anchor Steam* is unique, for their brewing process has evolved over many decades and is like no other in the world”.



Floreffe **Draught** **6.5%**

Brewed by Lefèbvre on behalf of Floreffe Abbey. This is a typical draught abbey blonde, sweetish and slightly bitter with some spicy notes.



Freedom Organic **Draught** **4.8%**

Brewed by a microbrwery in Staffordshire, and having received GB Organic Certification 5, this Lagered bier is produced to German purity laws. Malty and full of flavour, this is proving to be a real find



Freedom Pilsner **Draught** **5.0%**

Brewed to German purity laws, on a microbrewery in Staffordshire. Freedom Pilsner is a shining example of the classic Czech lager bier

Duvel Green

Draught 6.8%

Filtered and pasteurized keg beer related to the famous Duvel Ale. Golden in colour like its big brother and with subdued Saaz hop notes.



Liefmans Fruit

Produced primarily from English bittersweet apples, and undergoing the traditional cool filtration process, creates a cider with real character.



Aspalls Suffolk Draught

Draught has a mid straw colour with a floral/appley aroma especially of Russetts. It has a lovely mouth filling mousse and a delicate flavour of fresh pressed apples. It is an off dry cyder with a complexity that enhances its long finish.

A blond ale, it is brewed using four different varieties of aroma hop (Goldings, Spalt, Hallertau and Saaz).



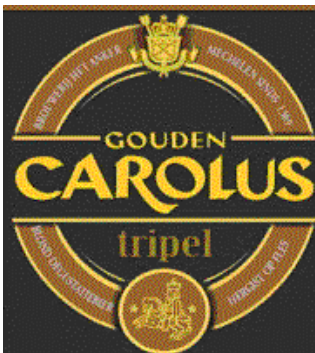
Gouden Carolus Classic 33cl 8.5%

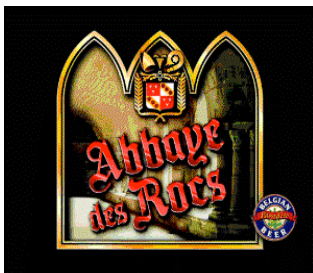


Oud Beersel Oude Geuze

Black Hole

Fairly new from the Roman Brewery of Oudenaarde, is Black Hole Pilsner. It is light golden with a white head. The aroma has notes of malt and flower. The flavour has a light sweetness and notes of malt, light flower and citrus, and the finish is dry and slightly bitter.



Piraat

A strong and robustly hopped blond/amber ale, not unlike a mighty IPA. Complex and rich.



Sloeber

Pale golden and lively with a dominant white head. It surprises you with its complexity of flavour. Dry on the palate with hints of orange.



Trappistes Rochefort 10

Dark brown color. Great strength balanced by a complexity of flavors and firm malt backbone. The bouquet covers a wide range: port wine, leather, apricots, oak, spices - a deeply intriguing beverage.



Trappistes Rochefort 8

The “middle” beer from the Trappist community of Notre Dame de Sainte Rémy’s range. Great big fruity flavours from this medley of dark roasted malts.

Guinness Foreign Extra Stout 33cl 7.5%

For the uninitiated this is Guinness at it's finest. Robust and dark, the liquorice and chocolate notes are followed by the obvious strength. This is stout from a forgotten age when quality was everything.



Gulden Draak 33cl 10.5%

A strong dark ale with a caramel-coloured head, it has aromas of burnt malt and coffee. Very full-bodied with hints of chocolate and caramel, its finish is very long and bittersweet.



Brooklyn Lager 33cl 5.1%

Brooklyn Lager is amber-gold in colour, and displays a firm malt centre supported by a fine bitterness and floral hop aroma. Caramel malt shows in the finish.



Becks 27.5cl 5%

Bottled Becks, imported from Germany, is known and loved by people everywhere. A good standard bottled lager bier, that is still brewed to German purity laws.



Corona 33cl 4.6%

Imported from Mexico, Corona is once again becoming the drink of choice amongst the trend-setting elite.

Served with it's trademark wedge of lime, this is a light, crisp and refreshing brew.

A rich, dark and tasty Dundee cake of a beer brewed in the abbey style. Subtle and slightly caramelized.

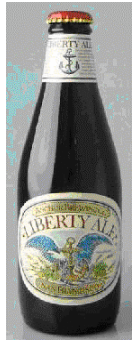


Flying Dog, Snake Dog IPA

Duvel 33cl 8.5%

Duvel is the classic Belgian Strong Golden Ale, brewed with Pilsner malt and white sugar, and hopped with Saaz and Styrian Goldings.



La Chouffe 33cl 8%

LA CHOUFFE is an unfiltered blonde beer, which is re-fermented in the bottle. It is pleasantly fruity, spiced with coriander, and with a light hop taste.



Mc Chouffe 33cl 8%

The Mc CHOUFFE is an unfiltered dark beer, which is re-fermented in the bottle. Behind its fruity flavour a slight hint of bitterness may be found



Vedett Extra Blond 33cl 5.2%

Vedett Extra Blond is a blond premium lager, of 5.2%. It was the first Vedett beer and has been known as an Export Beer by Duvel Moorgat since 1945.



Vedett Extra White 33cl 4.7%

Vedett Extra White has a delicious refreshing taste, surprisingly crisp, punctuated with an orange and lemon like zest, and rounded with a mildly bitter taste and dry finish.

Slaapmutske Blond

6.4%

Slaapmutske Blond is a full-malt top-fermentation beer with an alcohol percentage of 6.4 Vol% and with refermentation in the bottle.

The soft and tender taste is obtained using malts from barley and wheat. The spicy 'nose' is due to the use of very fine American, aromatic hop varieties. Slaapmutske Blond has a very pleasing full-malt taste and a round mouth feeling. The after-taste is tender and light bitter.



Slaapmutske Bruin

Slaapmutske Bruin is a full-malt beer with refermentation in the bottle. The beautiful deep-red colour is obtained using a combination of different colour-malts. The alcohol percentage is 6.0 Vol%. By using colour malts together with aromatic hops and some coriander we become a full, light sweet beer with a full-flavoured, spicy after-taste.



Slaapmutske Tripel

Slaapmutske Tripel is a golden, blond beer of top-fermentation with refermentation in the bottle. To brew this beer of 8.1 alcohol Vol% pale and coloured barley malt is used. The fresh aroma and the spicy taste are due to the use of 2 very aromatic hop varieties.

The mouth feeling is malty and ends in a full-flavoured bitter after-taste. The refermentation provides a fine and creamy foam that sticks to the glass.



Maredsous Blond

Maredsous 6 is a delectable Blonde ale with sprightly fruitiness, soft malting, and a slightly dry, gently-hopped finish. A sparkling nose, complex flavors, and a touch of bitterness give this fine ale all of the refreshing qualities of a classic Belgian Blonde.



Maredsous Bruin

Maredsous 8 is a rich mahogany-brown Dubbel ale, with a delicate body, creamy head, and lush bouquet. Within its velvety taste you'll discover subtle hints of dark fruit, chocolate, and toffee. You'll also savor a dry and warming finish.

Val-Dieu Blonde

At first taste sugared, then slightly bitter, being made from two traditional hop varieties. Little after-taste on a very slightly bitter base. Extremely digestible and refreshing.



Val-Dieu Brune

If its aroma reminds you of coffee/mocha, the mocha taste disappears, leaving only a slight coffee flavour, with almost no bitterness. Piquant like the pale ale.



Val-Dieu Triple

Its a full bodied taste is progressive but never excessive. A slightly sugared flavour in the middle of the mounth - a perfect combination of alcohol, bitterness and sweetness. Finally accentuates an aromatic and alcohol bitterness



Meantime Raspberry

Raspberry Grand Cru has a vibrant red colour and a fine white head. The beer has a full raspberry fruit nose, a balance of sweet and sour fruit on the palate and a wildly refreshing zesty finish.

Delirium Tremens

Delirium Tremens is very bright, despite its being bottle conditioned. It has a dense head, a very fruity bouquet, a sweetish palate, and a lot of warming alcohol in a rather abrupt finish.

The hops used include not only Saaz but also Styrians, and its fermentation demands three different yeast cultures.



Lucifer

A Belgian golden ale. On the nose it is lightly hoppy and yeastily spicy, with faint caramel malt notes and a touch of citrusy and estery fruit. The head tastes extremely bitter, as is often the case with this style. Surprisingly fruity, but with a strong hoppy bitterness.



Maisel's Weisse

Maisel's Weisse has a deep amber colour, with a delightful citric aroma and palate with a smooth dry finish.



Schneider Weisse Original

The full complexity of the genuine Bavarian wheat beer – great with hearty food.

Goose Island IPA

Goose Island India Pale Ale recalls a time when ales shipped from England to India were highly hopped to preserve their distinct taste during the long journey. The result is a hop lover's dream with a fruity aroma, set off by a dry malt middle, and long hop finish.

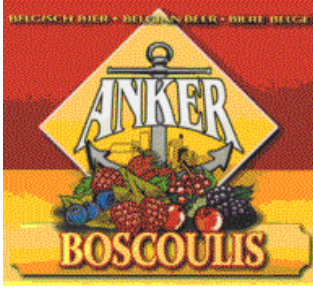

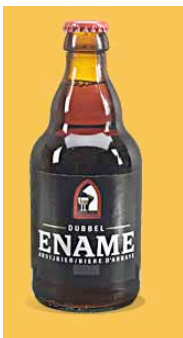


Ename Blonde

Aspalls Peronelles Blush

Deceptively smooth with a silky but refreshing palate, Blush offers a perfect blend of sweetness and acidity. It has a lovely mouthfeel and a lingering aftertaste of berries.
